

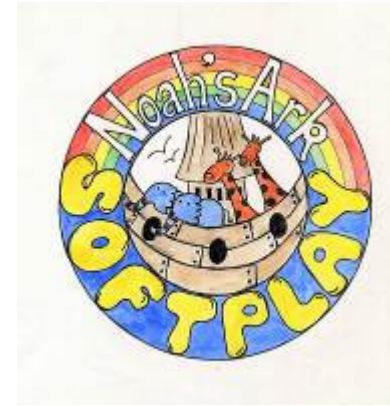
# The Safety Rules for the children

1. Go to the toilet before using the Soft Play.
2. Clean hands and faces.
3. No shoes. Socks must be worn.
4. Cover your arms and legs.
5. No toys, sweets or drinks in the Soft Play.
6. No earrings or necklaces.
7. If you feel unwell, tell an adult.
8. No screaming or shouting.
9. If you hear a whistle, stop and be quiet.

## Please read the following details carefully:

- In the interest of health and safety Noah's Ark reserves the right to exclude anyone from the Soft Play due to illness or infection.
- Signing in and out is important for fire and security reasons. **Please ensure you sign in when you arrive and sign out as you leave.**
- Please be aware that **whilst your child is attending you are responsible for them.**

**Our staff reserve the right to refuse access to the facility, to breakers of the rules or for unacceptable behaviour.**

**All accidents should be reported and recorded in our accident book.**

**Supervision is given by our volunteers; however, the adult who brought each child is required to stay in the building at all times.**

**We can only run our sessions because of people volunteering to help, if you want to know more please speak to us. Then we may be able to open more often – Full training is given.**

## Our Safety Rules

1. Children should go to toilet before using the Soft Play.
2. Only eat food - once you have finished in the Soft Play. (*Re-entry is allowed 10 minutes after eating.*)
3. All hands and faces must be clean.
4. No shoes to be worn inside.
5. Cover arms and legs - socks must be worn.
6. No sharp objects, jewellery, toys, food or drink are allowed in the Soft Play.
7. No one who feels unwell or has their face painted etc, is allowed in the Soft Play.
8. No screaming or shouting policy.
9. If you hear a whistle, leave the play area quickly and as safely as possible.
